- A. Major concepts/content.** This course will provide an in-depth study of the leadership techniques of decision making, problem solving, meeting skills, communication, group conflict reduction, time and stress management, evaluation, team building, group dynamics, motivational strategy, and the role of leadership in a democratic society.

The content should include, but not be limited to, the following:

- study in self-understanding
- development in self-esteem, goal setting, and character building
- enhance leadership skills and learn to follow for functioning in a group setting and the community

C. Intended outcomes. After successfully completing this course, the student will:

1. Demonstrate an advanced understanding of the concepts of leadership, its roles, responsibilities and hazards in a democratic society.
2. Demonstrate a knowledge of decision-making and problem-solving techniques.
3. Demonstrate a knowledge of and a competency in using meeting skills.
4. Demonstrate advanced knowledge and competency in communication skills and techniques.
5. Demonstrate a knowledge of the techniques of time and stress management.

6. Demonstrate a knowledge of the techniques for dealing with group needs and conflicts.
7. Demonstrate an understanding of the techniques and methods of evaluation.
8. Demonstrate a knowledge of and a competency in planning, goal setting, group dynamics, team building, and motivational strategies.
