High School Awards
Medallion Council Award

All member schools are eligible to be named Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medallion Councils if the **minimum requirements** have been met. These requirements are:

- The school must have a copy of the SGA Constitution on file with the county office.
- High schools must attend at least seven (7) BCASC meetings during the school year in which they plan to apply for Medallion Council.
- High schools must participate in all three (3) BCASC projects during the school year in which they plan to apply for Medallion Council and ***submit their project report to the project chairperson by the established deadline.***
- High schools must participate in three (3) BCASC events during the school year in which they plan to apply for Medallion Council.
- Project categories are citizenship development; community service; environmental concerns, faculty/staff relations; health & safety; membership motivation; school spirit; and, school service.
 - To qualify for a **Gold Medallion**, a council must complete projects in all **7** categories.
 - To qualify for a **Silver Medallion**, a council must complete projects in at least **6** categories.
 - To qualify for a **Bronze Medallion**, a council must complete projects in at least **5** categories.
- Awards will be provided by the Department of Athletics & Student Activities.
- The Medallion Council Awards are based on a point system, with points being awarded for meeting attendance and the level of participation in BCASC sponsored projects.
- **All forms must be completed and received in the Department of Student Activities by Thursday, April 2, 2020.**
- The points necessary for each award are as follows:

Gold	1500
Silver	1200
Bronze	700
